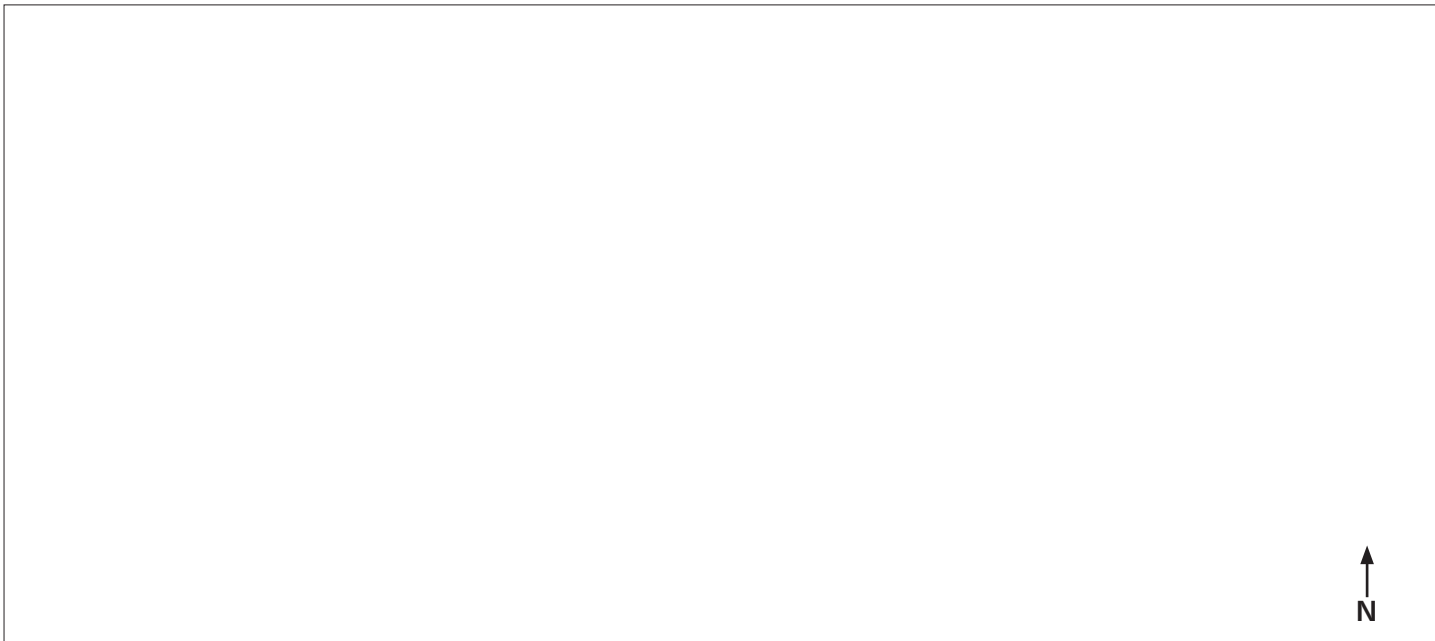

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PART 5 Insurance

1. Insurance

Permits will not be issued unless you have public liability insurance for the Work Zone area. A Certificate of Currency must be provided along with this application.

All certificates must include Warringah Council to be listed as an interested party and have a limit of liability of at least \$10,000,000.

I (name of applicant) have attached a copy of a valid insurance documentation and understand that this insurance shall not be cancelled or lapse without the agreement of Warringah Council and the policy document shall be endorsed to this effect. This insurance includes the cross liability clause.

PART 6 Conditions

1. The relevant fees (rental charges & deposit) must be paid in full before the Work Zone can be established.
2. The Work Zone area shall be signposted 'Works Zone' with appropriate hours conforming to the hours of building works stipulated by Council on the relevant development consent. These hours of operation would normally be from 7.00am to 5.00pm Monday to Friday and 8.00am to 1.00pm on Saturday. Clearways and peak hour parking restrictions must remain in force. Any variation to these times must be approved in advance by the Warringah Traffic Committee. Unless signposted

otherwise, Work zones will revert to normal parking outside these operating hours.

3. The applicant must provide safe pedestrian access through the Work zone area during the hours of operation.
4. Vehicles parked in a Work Zone shall comply with rule 181 of the Australian Road Rules for a Work Zone:
A driver must not stop in a work zone unless the driver is driving a vehicle that is:
 - a. engaged in construction work in or near the zone; or
 - b. permitted to stop in the work zone under another law of this jurisdictionA Work Zone is a length of a road to which a Work Zone sign applies.
5. Goods and material are not to be stored in Work Zones. A separate permit must be obtained in advance from Council for storage of materials on the nature strip and or footpath. Additional fees apply.
6. The Work Zone is subject to approval from the Warringah Traffic Committee. Any applications which fall on State Roads or which otherwise are considered to potentially have a major impact on traffic may require further approvals. These may include external authorities such as the NSW Police and the RTA.
7. All building waste containers (skips) should be located within the construction site boundaries and not in the work zone area. Permission to locate a skip in the Work Zone area will only be granted in exceptional circumstances where no storage space is available within the site. A separate application will be required to locate a skip bin on a road reserve.
8. The applicant must notify Council's Traffic Management (telephone 9942 2111 fax 9942 4522) in writing at least two weeks in advance of the date upon which the Work Zone expires and would be no longer required. Failure to do so will result in the applicant being held legally liable for the continued Work Zone rental charges for the period of time that it takes to remove the Work Zone. At the Council's discretion, this may also invoke the partial or full forfeiture of the Construction Zone Deposit.
9. Applicants wishing to extend the Work Zone must notify Council in writing within two weeks in advance of the Work Zone expiry date. Extension of the Work Zone is subject to Council's consideration and payment of the additional rental fees.
10. During the full period of construction of the project, the applicant shall be responsible for maintaining all traffic and parking restriction signs associated with the implementation of the Work Zone adjacent to the building site. This includes Work Zone signs and/or other parking restriction signs introduced by Council to facilitate the building works. At no time shall the applicant, builder, or any sub-contractor attempt to remove, add or relocate such signs. This may invoke the partial or full forfeiture of the Construction Zone Deposit.
11. Warringah Council reserves the right to cancel the Work Zone and any other kerbside allocation near the building site at any time.
