Warringah Council is providing a service to install Driveway Delineation Lines for residential, commercial and industrial property owners to assist vehicular access to a property driveway. This can be particularly useful in areas with limited road width and high on-street parking demand.

Driveway delineation lines are not a recognised traffic facility and therefore they cannot be enforced under the Australian Road Rules if they are encroached. However it is illegal for a vehicle to be partially or completely obstructing a driveway and consequently such vehicles can be infringed by the Police or Council's Compliance Officers.

To apply for driveway delineation, complete all relevant parts of this form and return it with payment to the Customer Service Centre.

Properties where vehicular access is on a classified main road (State Road) are not eligible to apply. Please refer to Part 4 for a list of State Roads in Warringah.

Please allow at least four (4) weeks for completion.

PART 4 Conditions

1. Driveway delineation Lines are offered to properties where vehicular access is situated at a Council road (including Regional Roads). Properties where vehicular access is on a private road or on a classified main road (State Road) are not eligible to apply.

2. Driveway delineation lines will be the same used to delineate on-street parallel car parking spaces marked in accordance to Australian Standards. The lines will be L-shaped and extend a maximum of 2.1 metres from the face of kerb into the carriageway.

3. Driveway delineation lines will be positioned up to a maximum 1 metre on either side of the gutter crossing. This cannot be relocated once installed except under special circumstances.

4. Driveway delineation lines are not a recognised traffic facility and therefore they cannot be enforced under the Australian Road Rules if they are encroached. However it is illegal for a vehicle to be partially or completely obstructing a driveway and consequently such vehicles can be infringed by the Police or Council's Compliance Officers.

5. Each application for driveway delineation lines are subject to approval from Council's Traffic Management Team.

6. Council will not be responsible for the maintenance of driveway delineation lines. Should these lines be required to be remarked, another application including the relevant fees should be submitted to Council.

7. If you are applying for consent as an individual, you may be providing Council with personal information (such as your name and address) within the meaning of the Privacy and Personal Information ACT 1998. You are obliged by law to provide your name and address. If you do not provide the personal information requested Council may be unable to process your application. Council is collecting this personal information from you in order to identify and process your application. You may make application for access or amendment to information held by Council. You may also make a request that Council suppress your personal information from being made publicly available. Council will consider any such application in accordance with the relevant legislation.
