Dogs

To comply with the NSW Companion Animals Act it is necessary for all dogs over the age of 6 months to be permanently identified and registered. From July 1999, owners have three years to transfer older dogs from annual registration to the new lifetime system. Permanent identification is through a rice size microchip injected under the skin in an animal's neck. Each chip contains a unique number that links the animal to the owner's details.
